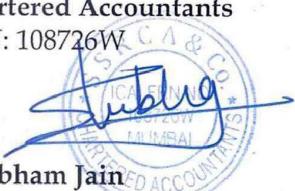

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the information provided by the management referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
6. This Statement includes the interim financial results and other financial information of an associate whose interim financial results/information reflects share of profit/(loss) amounting to Rs. (20,363)/- for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 respectively. The other associate has incurred significant losses, resulting in the accumulated losses exceeding the purchase cost of the investment. Therefore, the Company has discontinued recognizing its share of further losses in the consolidated financial results, in accordance with the requirements of Ind AS 28 - Investments in Associates and Joint Ventures, as the carrying amount of the investment has been reduced to zero. These financial statements are unaudited and have been furnished to us by the management and our opinion in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these associates is based solely on the information and explanation provided by the management.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matters.
